The bear goes to his ship. Animals drown.

BEAR. Good bye, losers!

ANIMALS. Help! Help! Save us! The Bear has broken our ship!

NARRATOR. Once upon a time there lived an old man and an old woman. They had a grandson – Gingerbread Man (in Russia we know him as Kolobok). He had a bad character and a criminal lifestyle, that's why his Grandfather Pirate and Grandmother Pirate had many problems with the police. They wanted him to become a sailor and they sent him to the port where there were many pirates' ships. He had to become a ship's boy.

KOLOBOK. Hello, cap!

HARE. Hello! Are you looking for a job?

KOLOBOK. Yes, my granny and granddad pirates threw me out because I have a terrible character. I want to be a legendary pirate.

HARE. Would you like to be a ship's boy on my ship "Carrot bed"?

KOLOBOK. And what will I have to do?

HARE. You'll have to peel 30 kilograms of carrots every day.

HARE (takes out a knife). Then I'll kill you!

CINDERELLA

NARRATOR. Once upon a time there lived a poor girl. She had neither a mother, nor a father. She lived with her stepmother and her two daughters.

STEPMOTHER. You must wash the floor!

CINDERELLA. I don't want to wash the floor!

FIRST DAUGHTER. You must be beautiful! Take my cosmetics and make your face up!

CINDERELLA. I don't want to make up my face!

SECOND DAUGHTER. Then take my mobile phone and call the Prince.

CINDERELLA. I don't want to call the Prince.

STEPMOTHER, DAUGHTERS (together). And what do you want?

CINDERELLA. I want to be a pirate! I want to sail in the Pacific Ocean! I want to fight!

STEPMOTHER. Ha-ha-ha! You don't have a frock!

FIRST DAUGHTER. You don't have a bandana!

SECOND DAUGHTER. You don't have a ship!

STEPMOTHER, DAUGHTERS (together). You can't be a pirate!

CINDERELLA. Poor me! I don't have a frock! I don't have a chest! I don't have a ship! I can't be a pirate! But I want to!!!

CINDERELLA. I want to be a pirate. I need a bandana, a chest and a ship.

FAIRY. Ok. (does magic and makes necessary things). Are you happy?

CINDERELLA. Oh yes, my dear godmother! Thank you a thousand times!

NARRATOR. And she became a captain of a pirates' ship. She was the most terrible pirate in the Pacific Ocean. Everybody was scared of her. One day she had a fight with another pirates' ship.

Cinderella and Prince Pirate fight. During the fight she loses her bandana and goes away.

PIRATE. What a nice girl... oh, I want to say, what a terrible pirate! She is so kind and charming... Oh, I want to say, she is so cruel and aggressive! Oh, she has lost her bandana! I must find her! The bandana will help me!

Tries the bandana on to all the girls in the hall. Finds Cinderella.

There were no men in their family, because women pirates are really dangerous! Her name was Little Red Riding Hood. The name is very long, moreover, she didn't have any hood - she wore a red bandana, but tradition is tradition.

MOTHER PIRATE. Little Red Riding Hood! Come here, my dearest!

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD. Yes, Mummy!

MOTHER PIRATE. Have you robbed a ship today?

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD. Yes, Mummy!

MOTHER PIRATE. Have you cooked Black Spaghetti?

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD. Yes, Mummy!

MOTHER PIRATE. Have you cleaned your ship?

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD. Yes, Mummy! Come and see!

MOTHER PIRATE. Good girl. Now I have another task for you. Your granny...

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD. Oh, no! Is she ill again?

MOTHER PIRATE. No. Her ship is broken and she needs your help. Take this... and this... and this... (подаёт инструменты для ремонта корабля. Хммм, что же это может быть?)

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD. OK, Mummy, I'm ready.

NARRATOR. And the brave girl went to her granny who lived on a desert island 5 miles away. Suddenly, she saw a big black ship. It was Big Bad Wolf – an extremely dangerous pirate.

WOLF. Hey, my honey! Where are you going?

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD. Hey, you! I'm not your honey! I'm a pirate!

WOLF. Pirate? Are you kidding?

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD. Here is my frock. Here is my ship. Here is my bandana.

WOLF. And where is your treasure chest?

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD. It is in my granny's house. It is too heavy to carry it.

WOLF. And where does your granny live?

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD. On a small desert island. Here. (shows him the map).

WOLF. Aha! Now let's see whose ship is faster!

NARRATOR. And they drove their ships to a small desert island in the Pacific Ocean. The Wolf's ship was faster. So he came to the small desert island where Granny was repairing her ship.

WOLF. Hello, old woman! What are you doing? Let me help you?

GRANNY. Me? Old woman? I'm the most terrible pirate in this ocean!

WOLF. No! I'm the best pirate in this ocean!

GRANNY. Are you sure?

WOLF. Let's see.

Granny and Wolf fight. Wolf wins. While they are fighting, glamorous neighbour pirates come in.

NEIGHBOURS.

- Oh, look!
- He calls himself a pirate!
- His frock is out of fashion.
- His bandana is of wrong colour!
- In this season pirates wear pink. It's so cool!
- Let's help him!

They change Wolf's clothes. Now he is wearing a pink bandana, ...

WOLF (cries). Oh, poor me! What shall I do? I was the best pirate in this ocean... Who am I now?

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD (comes in). You ARE the best pirate in this ocean! Your ship is fast, you are tall and strong... Let's go robbing together!

WOLF. OK! ... And ... where is your pirate's chest?

GRANNY. Here it is! (gives them the chest). Be happy, children!

HAPPY ENDING
